Dear Stockholder:

Each year at this time, your Board of Directors sends out an application for membership tags and in doing so wishes to remind everyone of the rules pertaining to the use of these tags. These and other rules are listed on the reverse side of this letter.

Membership tags are required for admittance to the swimming facilities of the lake and must be visible at all times while on the beaches, floats or Picnic Island. They are also required during the winter for ice fishing. Your cooperation in adhering to these rules is appreciated as a means to maintain the quality and integrity of the lake and this community.

PLEASE FILL OUT AND RETURN THE ENCLOSED TAG APPLICATION TO THE CLPO SECRETARY. Your tags will be prepared and mailed to you. Membership tags will be issued to all eligible stockholders or their tenants (**not both**) who reside at Cedar Lake. **2012 tags are required starting Memorial Day Weekend, May 25-28.** In order for you to receive your tags by Memorial Day Weekend, your completed application should be returned to the Secretary at least two weeks prior to Memorial Day weekend.

Each boat requires (1) tag. In order to assist us in maintaining the use of the lake for its paid stockholders and eligible guests, please install one boat tag on all of your boats, regardless of whether they are kept on a landing or on private property. Boat tags provide a quick way of notifying boat owners when their boats have been found adrift. **Boat tags (like membership tags) are required by Memorial Day weekend.** At landings, untagged (unidentifiable) boats are subject to removal and there will be a \$50.00 (per boat) reclaim fee assessed. **Please note that non-Cedar Lake boats are NOT permitted on the lake, even if they belong to guests.**

Should you wish to drop off your completed application at the CLPO Office, there is a special CLPO mailbox located next to the stone pillar on the landing side at **91 Cedar Lake East.**

Swimming instructions are given by the Swim Counselors to members of paid-up stockholders' families or his/her tenants' families who reside at Cedar Lake during this period. The swimming program participant's fee covers lessons and/or Swim Team participation. This year's fee remains at \$45.00 per child with a maximum of \$100.00 per family. A sign up form is included for your convenience. Please make checks payable to the Cedar Lake Property Owners, Inc. The Swim Team events for paid-up Community Club members are under the supervision of the CLCC.

MEMBERSHIP TAG RULES

1. **Membership tags are for the use of the residents to whom they were issued and are not to be used by any residents who are unpaid eligible stockholders or stockholders in arrears. Membership tags are not transferable.**
2. **Only stockholders OR their tenants who reside at Cedar Lake may be issued family tags. Stockholders and tenants are not both eligible for family tags. Frequently visiting guests and relatives MUST use guest tags.**
3. **Current year membership tags will be required on all beaches by Memorial Day weekend.**
4. **All tags will be mailed to stockholders free of charge in time for Memorial Day weekend upon receipt of their Membership Tags and Decals application form.**
5. **Tags must be displayed on one's person at all times when using beaches, floats or islands.**

Tags are issued:

For adults (16 years of age or over). A person must be 16 years of age by June 1st to qualify for an adult tag.

Ages 13-15. Child must be able to swim 25 meters unassisted to attend the beach unaccompanied and can supervise younger children. Must be 13 years of age by June 1st to qualify for a 13-15 tag.

Ages 10-12. Child must be able to swim 25 meters unassisted to attend the beach unaccompanied but cannot supervise younger children. Must be 10 years of age by June 1st to qualify for a 10-12 tag.

Ages 6-9. Must be accompanied by an adult or a person 13 years of age or over who is designated as the responsible party. Must be 6 years of age by June 1st to qualify for a 6-9 tag.

Under 6 years of age—These children are not issued tags and must be with an adult or person 13 years of age or over who is designated as the responsible party.

6. **Each stockholder will be issued a maximum of 4 guest tags without charge. If a stockholder requests additional guest tags for the season, a \$5.00 fee/tag will be charged. There is a \$1.00 replacement fee for a lost membership tag and a \$5.00 fee for a lost guest tag.**
7. **Current year tags are required for swimming and ice fishing. Retain tags if you anticipate ice fishing during the winter of 2012-2013. Tags will be required for identification. Swimming, ice fishing and ice skating are at your own risk.**

Beach Parties: There will be a \$5.00 deposit for each guest tag requested for parties with \$4.00 reimbursed to the stockholder upon return of the tag(s). The tag(s) should be returned within one week of the party date. **AT LEAST ONE WEEK'S ADVANCE NOTICE IS REQUIRED FOR PARTY ARRANGEMENTS.** The person who requests the party tags must hire a certified lifeguard (through our Swimming and Water Safety Chairperson) for every 15 party tags purchased. Party tags will be issued at the Board's discretion.
